If your property will need a DEP Site Check:

Prior to the release of the building permit for the above referenced case, a wetland determination by the State of Florida Department of Environmental protection (FDEP) is necessary. According to Lee County Soil Survey data, the soil type historically found on this parcel location is categorized as one of the hydric soils with the likelihood of wetland presence. Therefore, a site visit by DEP is required to verify the presence or absence of functioning wetlands. Please note that your building permit will not be issued until this determination has been made.
